What do I need to do to prepare before you arrive?

Please make sure your refrigerator have enough room for placement of ingredients, which will also come in handy for any potential leftovers. Having an accessible/empty trash can and a kitchen free of any clutter or dishes that haven't been put away, is also beneficial.

What's your cancellation/refund policy?

It is understood that you may need to reschedule because of illness/emergency, in which case we will be happy to offer you the next available timeslot. Otherwise, because we have reserved the day for you in addition to the fact that this service requires the purchase of ingredients ahead of time, changes must be received a week in advance for full credit. A request to cancel within this timeframe will incur a charge at a rate of \$100/hour for time already spent in addition to any hard cost, where applicable. If a date change is requested, client may incur an additional grocery charge, as groceries may need to be re-purchased.
